



OSSAP-BIOS Foreign Fellowship - 2020



Guidelines and Criteria

About Fellowship:

With an intention to increase the training opportunities to the OSSAP members, OSSAP has entered into an MOU with British Indian Orthopaedic Society (BIOS). The duration of fellowship is minimum of 4 weeks with an option for extension as per the mutual convenience of candidate and the host centres.

- Only Life Members of OSSAP residing in Andhra Pradesh are eligible.
- Application must be submitted to the Secretary OSSAP.
- Send only Xerox copies; do not send originals as they will not be returned.
- One set of application must contain
 - a) Personal Profile Statement
 - b) Curriculum Vitae
 - c) Relevant Authenticated Xerox copies
- BIOS would provide fellowship rotation through different hospitals in UK, with observational attachments that match the requirement of the fellow as much as it is practical.
- The travel and local hospitality cost of the fellowship has to be born by the individual. No monetary support will be provided by BIOS. BIOS will be happy to provide advice and help regarding accommodation and internal travel.
- The fellows are expected to submit a report of their fellowship experience within 4 weeks of completion of the fellowship.
- Selection of the fellows will be through an open and transparent process, agreed between both organizations. The selection of the fellows will be done during the OSSAPCON meeting.
- The panel of the selection committee would include a nominated representative of BIOS.
- The selected candidate will need to provide a certificate of good standing provided from the OSSAP and or the AP Medical council. The candidate will also need to provide a police clearance that there are no outstanding issues against them.
- Fellows will need to be aware of their responsibilities and behavior in relation to the local culture whilst they are in the UK.
- The fellows are allowed to present their fellowship experience in the OSSAP OACON meeting the following year.
- Communication only in writing or e-mail is entertained.
- Any wrong information or canvassing will disqualify the application.
- Applicant must have a valid passport and shall obtain Visa to travel in proper time.
- Selected applicant should proceed for overseas fellowship with valid Medical Insurance.
- Those candidates who are in government employment will need to provide a letter of support from their director or head that they support concerning period out of employment or No Objection Certificate.



Personal Profile statement:

A personal profile statement is a vital part of the candidate's application for Fellowship & is his introduction to the selection committee. An excellent personal profile statement must be relevant, short & to the point (max one page). It is a short statement outlining his personal characteristics in his own word. It tells the reader the attributes and qualities that he possesses and the experience he has & should demonstrate that he is capable of doing & can inspire others around him.

3. Interview :	20
